Our goal is to create a format that will allow the fulltime staff at the Goodman to have employment during COVID-19, as well as offering the Chicago Public School System a program that can deliver artistic education in a virtual learning semester. We are working on applying for grants to cover basic materials for a Stagecraft Kit that would be sent to each student and would provide a bit of hands on learning in costume construction, scenic carpentry, scenic painting, electrical work, and audio engineering.
